The Langley Village Project is moving forward.

Members of the Langley Parochial Church Council (LPCC) and the Langley Community Centre Committee (LCCC) are working together to provide improved facilities for the benefit of all present and future users of the Church and Community Centre.

Following extensive research and consultations with the community, users of the Church and Community Centre, Historic England, Diocesan Advisory Committee (DAC), Uttlesford District Council's (UDC) Planning and Conservation Departments, HMRC, Architects, Engineers, Quantity Surveyor and other Churches and Community Centres, the Village Project is moving forward.

Planning applications for both the Church and Community Centre will shortly be submitted to UDC. The Church plans will also be submitted to the DAC for faculty approval.

The Langley Village Project is an ambitious task and will require much effort from the respective committees and the community as a whole. We would like help in the following areas: -

#### **The Church Proposals**

#### Phase 1

- Construct an extension to the rear accessed through the existing blocked up door way to provide a small kitchen and toilet
- Connection to mains water supply
- Connection to mains sewer
- Provide a controlled ventilation system to reduce humidity to improve air quality within the Church
- Rewire where required
- Renew electric heaters
- Remove the defective organ and replace with a compact version elsewhere (already achieved)
- Create open space for children's area and other activities by removal of some pews in addition to the organ above.
- Provide storage for chairs and tables.
- Arrange and encourage further suitable activities within the Church


#### Phase 2

- Weatherproof the porch by glazing and installing an external porch door
- Install benches to porch
- Redecorate the Church
- Provide cupboard and viewing area to house the Langley archive

#### The Community Centre Proposals

- Demolish the existing substandard sports pavilion and garage
- Construct a new combined Community Centre and Sports Pavilion designed to provide improved and flexible facilities fit for current and future use without burdening following generations with high running or maintenance costs.
- Demolish existing Community Centre when the new Community Centre is built
- Minor reconfiguration of the car park
- Provide enhanced landscaping incorporating hedging and trees
- Arrange and encourage further and varied community and sports activities both within the Community Centre and on the Green
